#### Warning

- ! Important Do not use forward facing before the child's weight exceeds 9 kg.
- Important Please read all instructions in this manual and in the vehicle owner's manual related to child safety seats carefully and understand them. Install and use the child safety seat as described in the instruction manual. Fallure to do this could result in serious injury or death of your child. Keep the instruction manual with the child safety seat for future use.
- Important! Because of potential medical issues inherent in low birth weight and premature infants, always have a trained professional, doctor, or hospital staff member assess the suitability of the child restraint prior to leaving the hopstial or using the child restraint.
- I DO NOT try to remove and labels on the child safety seat. Important information is contained on the labels.
- DO NOT modify or attempt to modify the child safety seat in any way.
- I DO NOT take apart or attempt to take apart the child safety seat except as instructed in this manual.
- DO NOT use the child safety seat with damaged or missing parts.
- DO NOT use damaged or frayed harness straps or vehicle belt.
- NEVER use this child safety seat without the car seat cover.
- DO NOT replace the child seat cover or harness with any other than the ones we recommend as these parts are integral to the child safety seat's performance.
- DO NOT use a child safety seat that has been in a crash. A crash can cause damage to the child safety seat that you cannot see.
- ! DO NOT use a second-hand child seat or child seat whose history you do not know.
- ALWAYS check the tightness of the restraint and the harness before each use.
- ALWAYS make sure all vehicle belts and harness straps are not twisted before each use.
- NEVER leave the child in the child seat when the harness straps are loose or undone.
- ! NEVER leave your child unattended even for a short time.
- DO NOT leave your child in this restraint for an extended period of time.
- I DO NOT use on the vehicle seats that face the sides or rear of the vehicle. Use the child safety seat only on the vehicle seats that face forward.

  According to accident statistics, children are safer when properly restrainted in the rear seating positions than in the front seating position.
- ! Make sure any straps holding the restraint to the vehicle should be tight, that any straps restraining the child should be adjusted to the child's body, and that straps not be twisted.
- ! Make sure any lap strap is worn low down, so that the pelvis is firmly engaged, shall be stressed.

This child restraint has been classified as "Universal" under more stringent conditions than those which applied to earlier designs which do not carry this notice.

If in doubt, consult either the child restraint manufacturer to the retailer.



#### 2.1 Rear-facing installation tips





DANGER! When a child is installed in a reverse installation of a seat, if hit by a car airbag, it will cause fatal injury which may result in death.



In any case, the child's safety seat can not be used in the car seat where the airbag has been activated.

Please read the instructions carefully so that you can use the child safety seat correctly




This section of the child's safety seat is equipped with a seat belt with a 3-point belt conveyor with the requirements of GB27887 or ECER16. It is not suitable for models with only 2-point seat belts.

- If the seat in front of an airbag, you can not install in this position.
- Only equipped with a three-point seat belt, can do this location to install.

## 3.1 ISOFIX preparation



3.1.1If your vehicle is not equipped with an ISOFIX guide sleeve, insert the two ISOFIX guides (02) that come with the child's safety seat into the ISOFIX fixture (01) (Fig 3.1.1)

Tip: The ISOFIX fixture is located between the seat of the vehicle and the backrest.

Please read the instructions in the car manufacturer's manual for ISOFIX fixed points.

3.1.2 Press ISOFIX release key (03) and push ISOFIX forward to release its to the furthest. (Fig 3.1.2)

# 3.2 Adjust the shoulder strap and head against the child when using a harness (Group 0 +, I)

3.2.1Press the central adjuster (04) to pull out both straps (05) at the same time. Please do not pull the shoulder pad (06) to release the harness to the longer position. (Fig 3.2.1)

Tip: Shoulder outlet can no longer be below the shoulder of the child or above the height of the ear.

3.2.2Pull up or down to press the adjustment ring (07), so that the head (08) is adjusted to the appropriate position of the child and is fixed. (Fig 3.2.2)

# 3.3 Adjust the head in the case of a child using a three-point vehicle seat belt (Group II, III)

3.3.1 Pull up the adjustment ring (07) to adjust the head to the appropriate position of the child and fix it. (Fig 3.2.1)

3.3.2 The correct adjustment of the safety seat head (08) is to ensure that the car seat belt diagonal part (09) in the best position, which can provide the best protection for children. The safety seat head (08) must be adjusted to bring about two fingers between the child's shoulder and the safety seat head (08). (Fig 3.3.2)

## 3.4 Tilt adjustment and 360 degree rotation adjustment of children's safety seats







3.4.1 Press adjusting handle according to the direction of arrow (10), keep seat unlocked, then seat can incline to an appropriate position (11), release adjusting handle (10), seat locks itself again. (Fig 3.4.1) (Fig 3.4.2)

3.4.2 Press adjusting handle according to the direction of arrow (32) to unlock seat (11), rotate seat (11) to an appropriate position, release adjusting handle (32), seat locks itself. (Fig 3.4.3)




## 4.1 Group 0 + (0-13kg) children ISOFIX + Top Tether + Harness







- 4.1.1 Please arrange ISOFIX according to Sector 3.1
- 4.1.2 Please ensure that five points safety belt is installed correctly at child safety seat. (refer to Sector 3.2)
- 4.1.3 Please adjust five points safety belt according to Sector 3.2.
- 4.1.4 Adjust seat to the uttermost inclined position and fix it according to Sector 3.4 (don't slide or rotate it).
- 4.1.5 Confirm whether seat is at an inclined position, on the seat targets at gear 5 at bottom seat. Then install child safety seat at the opposite direction to the driving direction of car. (refer to Fig 4.1.1)



4.1.6 Please insert two ISOFIX connectors (12) to ISOFIX guide sleeves (02) until tick is made. At the moment, ISOFIX indicator turns green (13). (Fig 4.1.1) (Fig 4.1.2)

Note: ISOFIX connector (12) is installed correctly only if the ISOFIX indicator (13) is completely green.

- 7. Ensure five points buckle is locked.

- 5.1.1 Please ensure five points safety belt is installed on child safety seat correctly. (refer to Sector 3.2).
- 5.1.2 Please adjust five points safety belt according to Sector 3.2.
- 5.1.3 Please adjust seat (11) to an appropriate position according to Sector 3.4 and confirm its is locked (can't slide).
- 5.1.4 Please adjust seat (11) to the forward position and confirm it is locked (can't rotate).
- 5.1.5 Please put child safety seat at car seat with the same direction as the driving direction of car. (Fig 5.1.1).
- 5.1.6 Adjust child safety seat to Gear 1 or 5. The seat has five gears. Gear 1 is upright position. Gear 5 is oblique position. (Fig 5.1.3)(Fig 5.1.4)
- 5.1.7 Please pull out three points safety belt of car, slide abdominal belt into two guiding belt hooks of foundation (23), insert plug of car belt into buckle and tighten car belt. (Fig 5.1.2)




- 5.1.8 Three points car belts 1 and 2 are located behind bed roll and between backrest of child seat and bed roll. (Fig 5.1.5) (Fig 5.1.6)
- 5.1.9 Tighten car belt and ensure car belt is not loose. (Fig 5.1.7)
- 5.1.10 Please install child seat according to the steps that child uses five points safety belt in 4.1.14.

In order to guarantee the safety of child, please check the following items after each installation:

- 1. Ensure that car belt is not twisted or loose.
- 2. Ensure that child safety seat sticks to car seat.
- 3. Ensure that five points safety belt sticks to child but doesn't press child.
- 4. Ensure that the adjustment of shoulder girdle is correct and not twisted.
- 5. Ensure the height of shoulder pad is same as that of child's shoulder.
- 6. Ensure five points buckle is locked.







- 5.2.3 Please adjust seat (12) according to Sector 3.4 and confirm it is locked (can't slide or rotate).
- 5.2.4 Put child safety seat on car seat at the same direction as the driving direction of car and seat child in safety seat.
- 5.2.5 Please adjust child safety seat to Gear 1. The seat has five gears. And Gear 1 is upright position.
- 5.2.6 Pull safety belt out, tie child with it and insert the spile of car belt into buckle (24). Tick will be made in normal situation (Fig 5.2.1)
  Warning: ensure car belt is not twisted
- 5.2.7 Insert waist belt (25) and abdominal belt (26) near the buckle of car belt (24) into guiding belt groove (27) below child's arms (Fig 5.2.2).



- 5.2.8 Insert the other side of abdominal belt of car belt (26) into the guiding belt groove on the other side (28). (Fig 5.2.3)
- **5.2.9** Put the upper part of shoulder girdle of car belt (29) into the groove of guiding belt hook(30) on headrest (08) and ensure car belt is not twisted. (Fig 5.2.4)
- 5.2.10 Please ensure the upper part of waist belt of car belt (29) is above clavicle of child rather than neck. Prompt: you still can adjust head rest if necessary.



- 1. Ensure waist belt (24) and abdominal belt (26) near car belt buckle (24) are in guiding belt groove (27).

- 5.3.4 Put child safety seat on car seat at the same direction as the driving direction of car and seat child in safety seat.
- 5.3.5 Please adjust child safety seat to Gear 1. The seat has five gears. And Gear 1 is upright position. (Fig 5.3.1)



5.3.6 Insert two ISOFIX connector (12) into ISOFIX guiding sleeve (02) until tick is heard.
At the moment, ISOFIX indicator (13) turns green. (Fig 5.3.1) (Fig 5.3.20)

5.3.7 Push safety belt until it sticks to the backrest of car seat. (Fig 5.3.3)





- 5.3.12 Put the upper part of shoulder girdle of car belt (29) into the groove of guiding belt hook(30) on headrest (08) and ensure car belt is not twisted. (Fig 5.3.7)
- 5.2.13 Please ensure the upper part of waist belt of car belt (29) is above clavicle of child rather than neck.

- 1. Ensure waist belt (24) and abdominal belt (26) near car belt buckle (24) are in guiding belt groove (27).
- 2. Ensure the other side of car safety belt is in the guiding belt groove on the other side (28).
- 3. Ensure the upper part of shoulder girdle of car belt (29) is in the groove of belt hook (30) on headrest (08).
- 4. Ensure the upper part of shoulder girdle of car belt (29) is above child's clavicle rather than his neck.




